Congratulations to our Tuitionworks UMAT Students

We wish to extend our congratulations to our Year 12 Tuitionworks students who recently sat the Undergraduate Medicine and Health Sciences Admission Test ('UMAT') on 25 July 2018.

UMAT 2018 scores were recently released in or about mid September 2018.

We advise that nine (9) of our students achieved a result of greater than 75% of which six (6) achieved a score of 85% or greater and two (2) of which achieved an outstanding result of 99%.

If your child did not receive a result of at least 75%, students should not feel discouraged as there are other pathways in getting into Medical School such as:

- James Cook University which do not require UMAT results as part of their selection process to gain entry to Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) or Bachelor of Dental Surgery however they do require subjects prerequisites of English, Maths B and Chemistry;
- La Trobe University requires an ATAR score of 99.4 and there is no UMAT requirement for Year 12 applicants;
- Graduate-Entry programs and academic excellence in the humanities and social sciences as well as succeeding in the Graduate Australian Medical Schools Admission Test ('GAMSAT') to gain entry into Medicine at:
 - Australian National University;
 - o Deakin University;
 - o Flinders University;
 - Griffith University;
 - Macquarie University;
 - The University of Queensland;
 - The University of Melbourne;
 - The University of Notre Dame (Fremantle and Sydney);
 - o The University of Sydney;
 - The University of Western Australia;
 - The University of Wollongong.

Introducing UCAT in 2019

On or about 25 September 2018, it was announced that the UMAT will now be replaced by the University Clinical Assessment Test ('UCAT'). The UCAT has its similarities to the UMAT with respect to assessing the same type of skills. The UCAT is a computer-based test and comprises five sections: verbal reasoning, decision making, quantitative reasoning, abstract reasoning and situational judgement.

Medical Interview Preparation Course

If your child has recently been invited for an interview for entry into the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS), which is based on the performance in the UMAT, we understand that interviews at The University of Adelaide will be conducted in late November and throughout December 2018.

We understand that invitations for interviews will sent to students will be sent via email by The University of Adelaide on or about 29 October 2018.
