

Medical Interview Preparation Course

If your child has recently been invited for an interview for entry into the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS), which is based on the performance in the UMAT, we understand that interviews at The University of Adelaide will be conducted in late November and throughout December 2019.

To assist Tuitionworks students to prepare for the interview, we are offering a Medical Interview Preparation Course, details of which are as follows:

Duration:	Two (2) days (all sessions compulsory)
Date & Time:	Wednesday, 20 November 2019 from 1pm to 4pm (3 hours); Saturday, 23 November 2019 from 9am to 12pm (3 hours)
Fee:	\$198
Registration by:	Saturday, 16 November 2019

The course aims to provide students with skills in:

- Strategies for answering common interview questions How to approach scenarios and widen their problem-solving abilities;
- Key communication and non-verbal skills;
- Mock interviewing with real questions and scenarios used in recent years; and
- General advice on how to approach the interview and logistical concerns.

Students shall also be provided with written personalised feedback on completion of the course.

If your child did not invited for an interview, students should not feel discouraged as there are other pathways in getting into Medical School such as:

- James Cook University which do not require UCAT results as part of their selection process to gain entry to Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) or Bachelor of Dental Surgery however they do require subjects prerequisites of English, Maths B and Chemistry;
- La Trobe University requires an ATAR score of 99.4 and there is no UCAT requirement for Year 12 applicants;
- Graduate-Entry programs and academic excellence in the humanities and social sciences as well as succeeding in the Graduate Australian Medical Schools Admission Test ('GAMSAT') to gain entry into Medicine at:
 - Australian National University;
 - Deakin University;
 - Griffith University;
 - Macquarie University;
 - The University of Queensland;
 - The University of Melbourne;
 - The University of Notre Dame (Fremantle and Sydney);
 - The University of Sydney;
 - The University of Wollongong.

IGNITE/Scholarship Preparation Course in 2019/2020

If your child is interested in sitting the Australian Council for Educational Research ('ACER') Scholarship Test or IGNITE Program through the ACER assessment, Tuitionworks will be running a IGNITE/Scholarship preparation course in 2019 and 2020 for current Year 5 and 6 Tuitionworks students.

Alternatively, if your child wishes to improve their overall academic ability, we also encourage your child to undertake our program.
