Term 4 2017 Test Results

Your child's end of <u>term test papers</u> and <u>report</u> will be <u>mailed</u> to your <u>home address</u> at the end of January 2018. For this reason, please inform our office if you have changed address recently. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause. We endeavour to return all test papers as early as possible.

Upon receiving your child's test results, it is important to remember that Tuitionworks classes usually cover content that is 6-12 months ahead of the school curriculum. This means that some students find the program challenging. However, if students achieve 55% in their end of term test, they are achieving a satisfactory level. If your child receives a mark of below 55% for one or more of their term tests, we recommend attending a Homework Help session in Term 1 2018 to go through the test(s) with a tutor.

Easter Long Weekend Term 1 2018*

To accommodate for the Easter long weekend in March/April, Tuitionworks will close for one week. From Monday 26 March 2018 to Monday 2 April 2018 students will not have classes. Students will be expected from Tuesday 3 April 2018 to resume normal classes.

The term fees for your children's tuition will be due in the first week of Term 1 2018. Please note that the last day to receive a discount is Saturday 3 February 2018. Late payments are not eligible for the 10% discount or sibling discount.

Term 1 2018 Enrolment

We will be contacting parents before the end of Term 4 2017 to confirm their enrolment for next year. However, we ask that parents confirm their child's enrolment as soon as possible. If you intend to <u>change the session</u> <u>time</u> for your child's tuition classes or <u>do not</u> <u>intend to return in 2018</u>, please inform our office as early as possible.

If we do not hear from you and your child is absent in the first week of Term 1, we will assume that you will not be retpurning and your child's place may be offered to another student on our waiting list.

Re-Structuring Homework Help Classes

If students miss a class or need extra help with their modules, we offer a free homework help class on Friday from 4:30 – 7:30pm.

There is an abundance of tutors during this time that are dedicated to helping students. We <u>schedule set times for students to work in small</u> <u>groups with a tutor and revise previous</u> <u>modules</u> to further their level of understanding. Please inform us if you this is something you would like your child to participate in. We have trialled this throughout Term 4 2017 and noticed a significant increase in student's focus and understanding during classes.

Make-Up Classes

This session is also for students who miss classes during the week. Unfortunately we cannot and do not under any circumstances permit students to make up classes during alternative classes.

We permit students to change days only once during the term. However, they must remain in that session for the rest of the term. We offer this flexibility to students because we understand their co-curricular activities may clash occasionally. We cannot account for every student's individual timetable, but we hope this arrangement is suitable for parents.
